## What's the cost? <br> The cost of getting grain from farm to ship

- Supply chain costs make up about 30\% of producer's production cost
- Port costs are about \$21/t or \$840,000 for an average ship
- Australian supply chain costs and efficiencies are not reported transparently, compared to our competitors'
